



Information on the use of an electronic surveillance system

The entire area of Dorothea Hotel Budapest (hereinafter referred to as "Hotel") is private premises that only guests, invitees, employees and contracted parties of the Hotel may access. In order to prevent any persons from entering the premises irregularly the security staff of the Hotel may apply measures permitted by the effective legal provisions against the persons accessing the Hotel area (for example asking proof of their eligibility and identity, asking information about their aim of staying, asking for presentation of their luggage or requesting them to leave the premises). Objects that may constitute particular danger to public security, cash equivalent to or exceeding the amount of EUR 10,000, or assets of such value, as well as objects prohibited by the internal policies of the Hotel are not allowed to enter the Hotel premises.

Please be informed that **an electronic surveillance system is operated** to monitor the events taking place at the Hotel premises, which records images. The equipment we use records your activities as well. For information on the exact location of the cameras and the areas they watch, as well as on more detailed conditions of the processing, please see the Policy on the use of the Electronic Surveillance system available at the front desk of the Hotel.

Legal basis for our processing is the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by third parties [Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR]. Legitimate interest of the Hotel and the purpose of processing is to protect the life, physical integrity and personal liberty of the persons staying in the Hotel area and the property of the persons staying in the Hotel area, to protect business secrets as well as to notice, to prevent and detect any infringements and to have any potential Hotel guest complaints duly examined. After a thorough analysis of cases leading to previous uses the recordings are stored on the designated servers of the Hotel for six days or, in the cases stipulated by the policy, thirty days, observing the data security measures specified for storage (including an electronic and restricted entry system and password protection). The electronic surveillance system is operated by Dorothea Hotel Zrt. (1026 Budapest, Pasaréti út 122-124.). The data may be accessed by the Hotel General Manager or, in his or her absence the Duty Manager, the Director of Loss Prevention, the Loss Prevention Supervisors and the Director of Engineering of the Hotel, as well as the Loss Prevention Officers of the Loss Prevention Department of the Hotel. Recorded images may be watched for contra checking based on any notices of unlawful circumstances or legitimate interests, provided, that such notice is well founded in order to detect unlawful acts and initiate measures necessary to stop them subject to the approval of the Hotel General Manager or, in his or her absence the Duty Manager or the Director of Loss Prevention. The Director of Loss Prevention of the Hotel is entitled to save recorded images while the Hotel General Manager is entitled to make decisions of forwarding saved images to the competent authorities.

If your right or legitimate interest is affected by the video recording you may request us not to destroy or delete the data within six days of the recording or within thirty days with respect to recordings stored for that period, verifying your right of legitimate interest.

Recorded images are transferred only in proceedings initiated due to crime or offence at the request of the police or other authority in compliance with the provisions of relevant laws and our Policy.

Your rights related to your personal data are defined by the law, pursuant to which you may

- a) be informed about our processing and receive data processing related information,
- b) request restriction of the processing, or the rectification, erasure of your data processed, and
- c) object to the processing of personal data, and
- d) may seek legal remedy in case of a violation of your rights.

You may exercise your rights by means of a letter addressed to the Director of Loss Prevention of the Hotel and sent by mail to the Hotel's address or electronically to the reception.dorothea@autographhotels.com e-mail address. You may also address your complaint regarding our processing to the Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information or to the court.
